- Flip-flops are not desirable, but if you have a pair that is dressy, that is permitted.






Attire: Details


You're invited to join in our Cap Decorating Celebration! Express yourself and share your excitement for what the future may hold for you and your classmates!

- This is a great time to reconnect with a WSD staff member from your past and in person.


Difference Makers will:

2023 Graduation Contract

To: WHS Graduating Seniors PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING AND ACKNOWLEDGE AGREEMENT BELOW.

The Graduation ceremony will be conducted according to the following guidelines:

- Attire: Dress, skirt, or pants suit (no casual pants, jeans or shorts), blue gown (supplied), dress shoes or sandals with low heels (no sneakers). "Dressy" flip-flops are permissible. Or shirt with collar and tie, dress pants, shoes (no sneakers or sandals), blue gown (supplied). No jeans or shorts.

- All students will wear a graduation gown completely zippered and a graduation cap with tassel. Absolutely nothing may be worn on the gown. It has been approved by WHS Administration that students in the Class of 2023 may decorate their caps this year for graduation. A SnapChat page will be created and shared with students in advance of the ceremony to post pictures of the decorated caps.

- By 5:00 p.m., students will report to the Auditorium. Students will be checked for business casual dress as outlined above.

- When lining up and when sitting on the field, students are arranged in a specific order which conforms to the graduation line-up. No student should make changes to this order.

- Any student who exhibits evidence of the use or possession of any unauthorized substance or possession of any unauthorized item will be removed immediately from the ceremony.

- Any student who exhibits any other inappropriate behavior that warrants dismissal will be escorted from the ceremony. The student and parent(s) will have to make an appointment with high school administration to receive the diploma.

We would like to offer you a Victory Lap of the Wissahickon School District! In this final farewell, you will have a chance to walk through the halls of the middle school and your elementary building as students and teachers line the halls to wish you farewell.

This Victory Lap will take place immediately following graduation practice on June 7, 2023. You will wear your cap and gown (which will be distributed at practice that morning) as you parade through the halls of the middle school and your elementary school. We will all walk to the middle school. After the Victory Lap of the middle school, you will head to your elementary school. *Those students who attended Mattison Elementary or did not attend a WSD elementary school are welcomed to participate at an elementary school of their choosing*. Buses will be provided to Stony Creek, Shady Grove and Blue Bell. Students are not permitted to drive themselves. For those of you who are Lower Gwynedd alum, we will walk to Lower Gwynedd. When the Victory Laps are complete, all seniors will return to WHS and you will be dismissed at that time. We anticipate that all groups will return to WHS by 11:15 that morning.

Tickets will be given out with your cap/gown during the Wednesday practice. No extra tickets will be available. Please do not lose your tickets. **Tickets are required!**

10 tickets will be given for graduation on the field.

We are hoping for an outdoor ceremony.

If the ceremony is indoors on June 9, you will receive 2 tickets for the Circle Gym.

Please understand that if your student has exceeded 10 days absent from school this school year, this absence or early dismissal will be marked as unexcused.

Listing Scholarships in the Graduation Program

- Each year at graduation we publish the names of scholarships earned by students in the senior class. If you would like your name and the scholarship(s) that you have received to be included in the program at graduation, please complete the online form (link sent out by Ms. Anderson) by May 9th. The following types of scholarships can be included:
 - Any scholarships from the college/university that you WILL attend. Please include the name of the college/university and the name of the scholarship (e.g. University of Delaware President's Scholarship, Drexel University AJ Drexel Scholarship). DO NOT INCLUDE SCHOLARSHIPS FROM COLLEGES THAT YOU WILL NOT BE ATTENDING.
 - Any outside scholarship awards that you have received to date from a private/community organization (e.g. parent's employer, local club, etc.)

Enrollment/Housing Deposits:

Pay by May 1 for 4YR college-bound students. If you plan to accept financial aid award offers, you should also follow any required steps given to you by your university.
Waitlists:

Even if you have chosen to stay on a waitlist, you should deposit elsewhere by May 1. Waitlist offers are likely to come later in May or June.

May 1st at all senior lunches! Wear the gear that represents your next steps. We will have a photo area set-up and the HSA will be giving out cookies.

Senior Spotlights:

Remember to stop by the Counseling Office to add your name and check out the senior map. This will highlight you on the WSD Social Media pages and the Class of 2023 Instagram page.

Update Your Outcomes in Scoir:

Before the end of the year, you should be entering all of your admissions decisions in Scoir and marking which school will be the one where you plan to enroll. Colleges must be moved to the Applied tab before you can note outcomes. This also helps future Wiss students look at data.

• Final Transcripts:

Final transcripts are <u>automatically</u> sent to the college that you indicate in Scoir immediately after graduation. This should be the school that you plan to enroll at in the Fall 2023 semester. You do NOT need to request this transcript.
