Goals Guiding Our Approach to Remote Teaching & Learning 2020-2021

- Maintain curricular program and pacing
- Provide daily synchronous instruction for all
- Provide instructional interventions and supports (IEP's, GIEP's, English Learners, Reading)
- Assess, evaluate, grade student work, and provide student feedback
- Hold students accountable for attendance and work completion
- Remain flexible with students and families as circumstances require in accessing lessons and completing assignments
- Attend to students' instructional, physical, and social-emotional needs
- Provide seamless transitions between the virtual and brick and mortar environments
- Maintain Pennsylvania's requirements for instructional days/hours

Technology & Instructional Tech Tools

- District-issued computer device for each student
- Familiar tech tools: Seesaw K-3, Microsoft Teams K-12, and Schoology 6-12
- Students can...
 - ✓ Engage in video-conferencing
 - ✓ Work with classmates in small “breakout” groups
 - ✓ Post documents and turn in assignments
 - ✓ Post responses to teacher prompts
 - ✓ Communicate with the teacher individually
 - ✓ Take assessments
