The following qualifications are required:

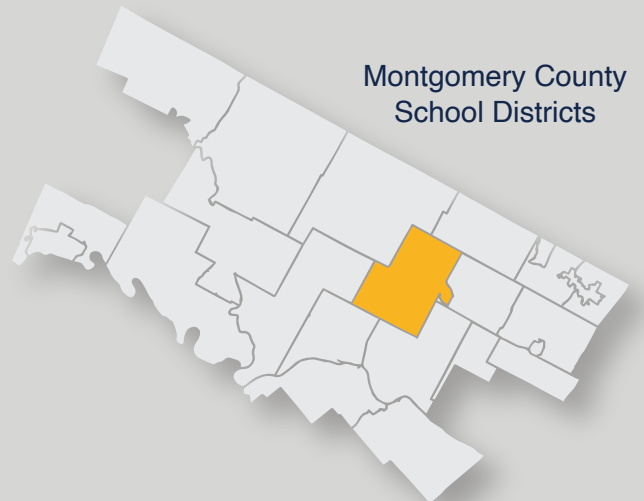
- Superintendent's Certificate OR Letter of Eligibility is required.
- Minimum of five (5) years of administrative experience required; central office experience preferred.
- Extensive knowledge of K-12 teaching and learning best practices.
- Expertise in data analysis, curriculum development, and teachers evaluation.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Oversight of the teaching and learning program, including professional development, curriculum design and implementation.
- Evaluation of instructional process; coordination and monitoring of the new teacher induction process.
- Creation and implementation of the district strategic planning process.
- Oversight of the District Assessment Program, analysis of achievement results and assistance with plans for improvement.
- Supervision of three Directors in the areas of Curriculum & Instruction, Student Services and Technology.
