I. PURPOSE

The Board recognizes the importance of establishing a comprehensive plan to guide the educational program and operation of the District. Participation by all segments of the school community is a critical element of such planning.

II. DEFINITIONS

None.

III. POLICY

A. The Board shall develop and approve a Strategic Plan for the school district based upon an analysis of internal and external needs, specifying priorities for actions and action plans. The plan shall be formulated in accordance with state regulations.

B. The Strategic Plan shall include the District's professional education plan, induction plan, student services plan, special education plan, and gifted education plan, pursuant to state regulations.

C. The Board shall ensure active participation by Board members, administrators, teachers, other District personnel, students, parents/guardians and representatives from businesses and the community.

D. The Board directs that the Strategic Plan be reviewed and revised during the third year of the six-year plan, and as necessary.

E. Prior to approval by the Board, the Strategic Plan, and any revisions, shall be made available for public inspection in the District's administrative office and the public library until the next regular Board Meeting.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for recommending the Strategic Plan to the Board and for submitting the plan to the Department of Education.
