I. PURPOSE

The Board wishes to establish written plans for implementing a comprehensive and integrated K-12 program of student services, the Student Services Plan, based on the needs of students.

II. DEFINITIONS

None.

III. POLICY

- A. Services offered by community agencies in district schools shall be coordinated by and be under the general direction of the District.
- B. The district's student services shall:
 - a. Be an integral part of the instructional program at all levels of the school system.
 - b. Provide information to students and parents/guardians about the educational opportunities of the school's instructional program and how to access those opportunities.
 - c. Provide career information and assessments to inform students and parents/guardians about work and career options available to individual students.
 - i. Provide basic health services required by law for students and provide information to parents/guardians about the health needs of their children.
- C. Require persons delivering student services to be licensed or certified as required by statute or regulation.
- D. The following categories of services shall be provided by the District and included in the Student Services Plan:
 - a. Developmental services that address students' needs throughout their district enrollment, which include: guidance counseling, psychological services, health services, home and school visitor services, and social work services that support students in addressing academic behavioral, health, personal and social development issues.
 - b. Diagnostic, intervention and referral services for students experiencing problems attaining educational achievement appropriate to their learning potential.
 - c. Consultation and coordination services for students who are experiencing chronic problems that require multiple services by teams or specialists including a plan for a student assistance program.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible to develop, implement, and monitor a Student Services Plan that complies with state regulations and is available to all students.
