TITLE: ASSIGNMENT WITHIN THE DISTRICT

I. PURPOSE

The Board directs that the assignment of students to classes and schools within this District shall be consistent with the educational needs of students and effective use of District resources.

II. DEFINITIONS

None.

III. POLICY

The Board shall determine periodically the school attendance areas of the District and shall expect the students within each area to attend the school designated. In assigning students to schools within this District, no discrimination shall occur.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

A. The Superintendent shall periodically review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board changes that may be justified by:

- a. consideration of safe student transportation and travel.
- b. convenience of access to schools.
- c. financial, administrative efficiency, and functional building capacity
- d. effectiveness of the instructional program.
- e. appropriateness of the instructional program.

B. The Superintendent or designee may assign a student to a school other than that designated in the attendance area when such exception is justified by special circumstances and is in the proper educational interest of the student.

C. The Superintendent or designee shall assign incoming transfer students to schools, grades, and classes that afford each student the greatest likelihood of realizing his/her educational and academic goals.

D. The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs and abilities of the student, as well as the educational program and administration of the school.
