## **ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES**

- A. In the case of a student with a disability, including a student for whom an evaluation is pending, prior to implementing any disciplinary removal or considering a change of placement for the student, the district shall coordinate with the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) team and take all steps required to comply with state and federal laws and regulations, and Board policies.
- B. The district shall ensure that the convicted or adjudicated student is prohibited from taking part in the following activities at the same time as the victim:
  - a. Being educated in the same school building
  - b. Being transported on the same school vehicle.
  - c. Participating in the same school-sponsored activity.
- C. Return of Student to School
  - a. The district may return the student who is expelled, transferred or reassigned, to the student's originally assigned school if one (1) of the following circumstances occur:
  - b. The victim is no longer enrolled in the district.
  - c. The conviction or adjudication has been reversed and is not pending appeal.
- D. Transfer Students
  - a. When the school district receives a student who transfers from a public or private school during or after an expulsion period for an act or offense involving a sexual assault conviction or adjudication, the district may assign that student to an alternative assignment or may provide alternative education services.
