I. PURPOSE

The Board recognizes the value of student social events in enhancing and enriching the school experience for students.

II. DEFINITIONS

III. POLICY

- A. The Board shall make school facilities available and provide appropriate staff for social events within the school facilities that have been approved by the building principal.
- B. All school social events must be sponsored by a student organization with the approval of the principal.
- C. For social events which take place outside of school facilities, approval is required by the Superintendent or his/her designee unless the social event exceeds a 50 mile radius or requires an overnight stay, in which case Board approval is required.
- D. Protection of instructional time is the highest priority. The number of social activities shall be limited to preserve instructional time. Decisions to allow in-school social events are at the discretion of the building principal. Limitation of the number of social activities is expected.
- E. Volunteers at events are subject to the district policies and regulations regarding volunteers.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall develop administrative guidelines regulating social events and insuring the District's compliance with applicable law.
