ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

- A. As voluntary participants in school social events, students shall be held responsible for compliance with District policies and rules. Infractions of those rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures applied during the regular school program.
- B. Participation in school events is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the policies and rules of the school. Rules for academic eligibility shall apply to social events.
- C. Procedures for the conduct of student social events which shall include the following:
 - a. Designation of a staff member who shall be the District employee responsible for the event.
 - b. Provision of adequate adult supervision or police protection, as required by the circumstances of the event. The principal shall determine the supervisory ratio for any social event in advance.
 - c. Formulation of rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of all participants and distribution of such rules and regulations to all students and adults involved.
 - d. Parental permission for any social event must be sought and obtained before any pupil may participate.
 - e. The principal must approve the purpose, itinerary, duration and cost of any proposed social activity.
 - f. Fees associated with social events participation (when applicable) are the responsibility of the parents of student participants. The building principal shall address special financial needs of students.
