## **ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES**

- A. Parental permission shall be sought and received before students may participate in any public performance off school grounds.
- B. When public performances are scheduled as a regular part of a planned course of instruction taken for credit, students shall be informed in advance of their obligation to participate; and they will be excused from participation only in accordance with the rules and procedures governing school attendance.
- C. Any compensation for a public performance shall be deposited in the school activity account and used for the benefit of the performing program.
- D. The interests of students shall be protected and guarded against exploitation.
- E. Principals are responsible for monitoring the frequency and impact of public performances by students.
- F. Teachers supervising public performances by students should submit a plan in advance to the principal for approval.
- G. Every effort shall be made to minimize the impact of public performances on the academic standing of students.
