ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

- A. A student who has reached the age of eighteen (18) years possesses the full rights of an adult and may authorize those school matters previously handled by a parent/guardian.
- B. Surveys/Evaluations
 - a. The parent/guardian/student over eighteen (18) shall be informed of the nature and scope of approved research studies and surveys and their relationship to the educational program of their child. The parents/guardians/students over 18 shall be given the right to inspect, upon request, any research study and/or survey conducted by entities other than the school district prior to administration or distribution to a student. Such requests for inspection shall be in writing and submitted to the building principal.
 - b. No student shall be permitted without written parental consent for students under eighteen (18) years of age or written consent of emancipated students or those over eighteen (18) years, to submit to a research study or survey conducted by entities other than the school district.
 - c. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall annually notify the parent/guardian of the contents of this policy and its availability.
