## **ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES**

- A. The Student Assistance Program (SAP) shall provide assistance in:
- a. Identifying issues that pose a barrier to a student's learning and/or academic achievement and/or health and well-being.
  - b. Determining whether the identified problem lies within the responsibility of the school.
  - c. Informing the parent/guardian of a problem affecting the student's learning and/or academic achievement and/or health and well-being.
  - d. Making recommendations to assist the student and the parent/guardian.
  - e. Providing information on community resources and options to deal with the problem.
  - f. Establishing links with resources to help resolve the problem.
  - g. Collaborating with the parent/guardian and agency when students are involved in treatment through a community agency.
  - h. Providing a plan for in-school support services for the student during and after treatment.
