I. PURPOSE

The District recognizes that it is essential to keep parents/guardians informed of their student's academic progress in school. A system of reporting student growth and achievement can help the student, teachers, and parents evaluate the student's progress toward attaining educational goals, and achieving proficiency in District academic standards and essential learnings. It recognizes the effects of State Board regulations and Federal regulations governing school records.

II. DEFINITIONS

Reporting Student Progress is defined as a system of measuring and recording student growth and achievement in school and progress toward attaining proficiency in District academic standards and essential learnings. Student progress and performance shall be measured against the levels of achievement expected for students at comparable grade levels while recognizing the student's own potential.

III. POLICY

The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress consistent with the educational goals of the District and inclusive of the District's academic standards, and essential learnings (see attached). The system of reporting and measuring student progress shall include written reports and parent/guardian conferences with teachers and shall require all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility. The types of progress reports shall be uniform throughout the District at comparable grade levels, shall be approved by the Board and shall reflect student progress toward attaining proficiency in District academic standards and essential learnings.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Superintendent or his/her designee, in conjunction with appropriate administrative and instructional staff, shall develop guidelines and procedures for implementing this policy and insuring the District's compliance with law.
