I. Purpose

The Board intends to offer a variety of learning and recreational experiences for residents of all ages. The Board believes that public school facilities should be used extensively by the citizens who fund them.

ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

Any resident of the Wissahickon School District who has reached the age of 62 is eligible to be a member of the Gold Card Club.

The Gold Card Club is non-transferable. It may be used for free admission to the musical, dramatic, and athletic events sponsored by the District.

The following procedures apply:

- For all athletic events (home games only), use the Gold Card as your pass.
- For any event where the sale of tickets is limited by seating capacity – to ensure yourself a seat, please present your card to the school office in which the event is scheduled to occur in exchange for a ticket prior to the performance date.

Keep in mind that many different community organizations use school facilities for programming. A Gold Card admits a resident free to most programs sponsored by the District, but the District cannot provide assurance that it can be used to provide admittance to any program sponsored by other groups.
